

2012-2015 Honda Civic (SI) 2.5" Cat-Back Exhaust System,304SS BH7306 Installation Instructions



Thank you for making HOOKER HEADERS your choice in a high-performance exhaust system. Extensive dyno/track testing has enabled HOOKER to offer the most advanced design in exhaust systems. The installation, while not complex, will take a certain amount of time. However, the additional horsepower and improved performance will more than justify your efforts. Proper installation and maintenance will ensure long life and maximum performance from your HOOKER HEADER exhaust system.

BEFORE STARTING:

Your vehicle must be raised a minimum of 36 inches. A floor hoist is ideal. If no hoist is available, we strongly urge the use of axle stands as a safety measure. Please read these instructions in their entirety before attempting installation.

CAUTION! WORK ONLY ON A LEVEL SURFACE. USE JACKS /JACK STANDS OF SUFFICIENT CAPACITY TO LIFT AND SUPPORT YOUR VEHICLE. NEVER WORK UNDER A VEHICLE SUPPORTED BY A FLOOR OR BUMPER JACK.

REMOVING THE OE EXHAUST:

- 1. Disconnect the negative cable from the vehicle battery.
- 2. Lift the vehicle and secure on jack stands.

3. Start at the front of the catalytic converter flange remove the (x3) 14mm head nuts and remove the (x2) 12mm bolt heads and remove the cross brace (**Figure 1**).



4. Remove the (x2) 12mm bolt heads and springs at the muffler flange (Figure 2).

5. Spray (x2) rubber isolators with wd-40 and remove mid-pipe (Figures 3 & 4).

6. Located the (x2) rubber isolators on the muffler, spray with wd-40, and remove muffler (Figures 5 & 6).

INSTALLATION:

1. Install the blackheart flange pipe to the OE catalytic converter flange tighten (x3) 14mm head nuts do not forget to check the OE gasket replace if needed. Install the cross brace and tighten (x2) 12mm bolt heads (**Figure 7**).



2. Use the 2 1/2" band clamp that was supplied with the kit, slide over the flange pipe (Figure 8).

3. Spray (x2) rubber isolators, remove off the OE mid-pipe hangers, and transfer them to the blackheart mid-pipe hangers (Figures 9 & 10).

4. Connect the mid-pipe to the flange pipe slide on the (x2) rubber isolators to the car hangers (Figure 11).



5. Remove the OE donut gasket off the OE mid-pipe. Inspect the OE donut gasket replace if needed; install the OE donut gasket to the blackheart mid-pipe (**Figure 12**).

6. Remove the (x2) rubber isolators off the OE muffler, transfer to the blackheart muffler hangers (Figures 13 & 14).

7. Slide in the blackheart muffler and slide on the (x2) rubber isolators on the car hangers (Figure 15).

8. Install the (x2) suppled 12mm head bolts and (x2) OE springs (Figure 16).



- 9. Line up the exhaust tip and tighten all clamps and bolts.
- 10. Remove the jack stands and lower the vehicle
- 11. After 150 miles, re-check and tighten all bolts and clamps.

NOTE: It is normal for the Blackheart Exhaust System to emit smoke for the first few minutes during break-in period.
