INSTALLATION:

- 1. Lift the vehicle and secure on jack stand.
- 2. Install two extra jack stands under the bottom side of the rear axle for safety.
- 3. Remove the factory bolts and nuts on the left and right side rear lower control arm (**Figure 1**).



4. Now, install right and left side skid plates using supplied hardware. Adjust for proper fitment and torque bolts and nuts to factory specs (**Figures 2, 3, & 4**).





POST-INSTALLATION:

1. Check for proper torque on all fasteners. Check clearance between all rotating, mobile, fixed, and hot parts.

MAINTENANCE: After 500 miles, re-torque all fasteners (recommended every 1000 miles thereafter). Have all suspension, driveline, and steering components inspected buy a certified technician during routine maintenance (recommended every 3000 miles).
